

The New Wanderer stitch along

Welcome to the New Wanderer SAL by Quaternion Creations - a journey through ten breathtaking destinations from all over the world.

We will start stitching in March 2024 and the last motif will be released in December 2024.

As with the previous Wanderer SAL, each release will be accompanied by a ghost story or an urban legend tied to the city we would be stitching.

Release schedule:

New motifs will be released once a month, on the 14th day of each month.
That will give you plenty of time to stitch without the added pressure!

First release date: 14.03.2024 (Thursday, March 14th)

Pattern size: 228 x 300 stitches, portrait orientation

Stitches used: Backstitches, blackwork, full cross stitches (no quarter- or partial stitches), French knots (very few and can be skipped altogether)

Most of the design is in one color (black, approx. 5-7 skeins depending on your usage), with occasional additions of colored accents (primary colors, can be stitched from stash).

The design is not full coverage, most of your fabric will be seen.

Approx. finished sizes:

Aida #14 -- 41,3 x 54,3 cm / 16,2" x 21,3"

Aida #16 (recommended) -- 36,3 x 47,7 cm / 14,2" x 18,6"

Aida #18 -- 32,2 x 42,3 cm / 12,6" x 16,5"

! Add extra 5-6 inches (10-12 cm) on each side for framing

Stitching notes

- The design is recommended for 16 count canvas or evenweave . There will be no partial stitches, so you can go with regular Aida without hesitation.
- Blackwork is most often stitched with Holbein (double running) stitches. If you prefer to do it in backstitching, the floss usage might slightly increase.
- There might be some places when it's easier to go twice with one ply over the same stitch rather than threading the needle with 2 ply for it.
- There might be several French knots in some of the motifs, I try to use them ever so rarely - if you are not sure, you can swap them for a seed bead or skip completely.
- Some of the straight stitches might cover more than one square on the fabric (up to five). No worries here, just make them long!
- As weird as it may sound to a seasoned cross-stitcher, try starting with the backstitched outlines! That will make the counting inside much easier.
