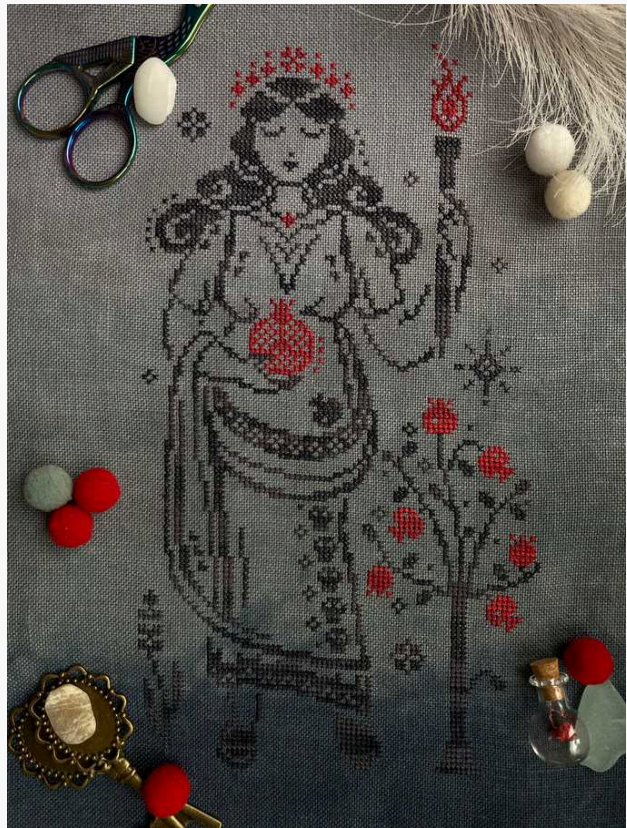


ABOUT US
